

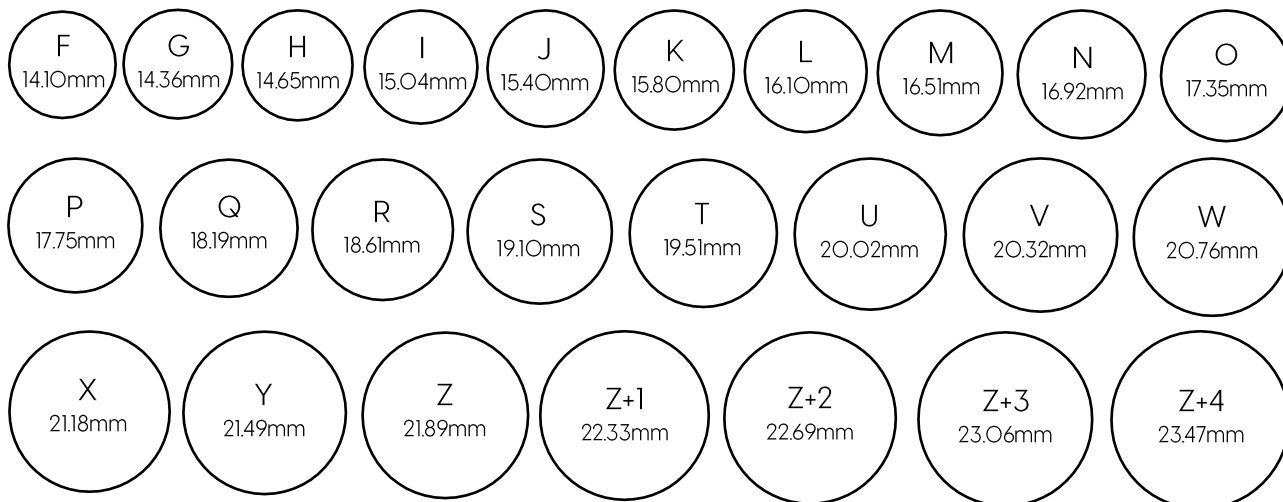

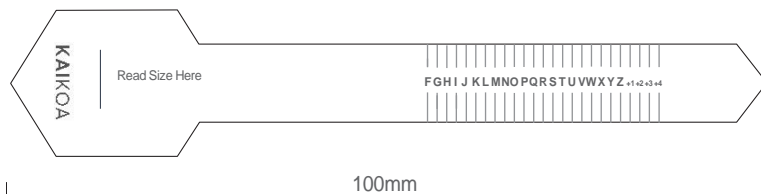
For accuracy this page must be printed at 100%. Make sure you uncheck the Fit to Page option in your print dialog box and set page scaling to 100% or actual size. Use a ruler to check the 100mm line below is exact. Do not attempt to measure this page on your screen.

Option 1

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger
2. Place the ring over the nearest matching circle below.
Match the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size.
3. If the ring size falls between two circles, order the larger size.
Double check for accuracy.



OPTION 2. CUT-OUT RING SIZER



Before measuring, please ensure to use a ruler to check the above line has printed to exactly 100mm.
Note – for most accurate sizing, measure warm hand, early evening is considered the best time to measure.

Place a single length of clear tape over the ring sizer shape to add strength, then cut carefully around the edge with a blade, also cut the vertical slit.

With the letters facing out, place around your finger at the widest point (usually the knuckle) and pull snugly after inserting the end of the sizer through the slit. The letter that lines up with the slit is your ring size.

Ensure the sizer can still slip over the knuckle. If the size is between two letters, choose the larger size.
